

## **TRAVEL GUIDE TO WEYMOUTH**

### **BY PLANE**

#### ***International Airports***

##### **London Heathrow**

Distance to Weymouth - 129 miles

From London Heathrow catch the bus from the Central Bus Station to Woking. From Woking you can catch a direct train to Weymouth. You can buy a ticket for the whole journey. Please check times at

##### **London Gatwick**

Distance to Weymouth - 151 miles

From London Gatwick, catch the train from Gatwick Airport to Clapham Junction (Please note this is a busy station, check the boards at the top of each platform to find correct departure platform) from Clapham Junction, you can get a direct train to Weymouth. Please note, you can buy a ticket for the whole journey.

##### **London Stansted**

Distance to Weymouth - 187 miles

#### ***Regional Airports***

##### **Bournemouth Airport**

Distance to Weymouth – 43 miles

For rail access to Bournemouth Airport use Bournemouth Station, located at the Travel Interchange. The Travel Interchange is also served by a regular hourly shuttle bus to the Airport.

From Bournemouth Station, you can get a direct train to Weymouth. Please check [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk) for details.

##### **Exeter Airport**

Distance to Weymouth – 61 miles

From Exeter Airport, catch the shuttle bus to Exeter St David's Train Station. From there, catch a train to Weymouth, details can be found on [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk)

### **Southampton Airport**

Distance to Weymouth – 68 miles

From Southampton Airport you can catch a direct train from Southampton Airport Parkway train station to Weymouth. Please check [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk) for train times.

We would suggest this is the most convenient airport to travel to and from. This is due to the airport being very close to the railway station and the direct train that you can get from there.

### **Bristol Airport**

Distance to Weymouth – 80 miles

The nearest train station to Bristol International Airport is Bristol Temple Meads, approximately seven miles away. The Bristol International Flyer express coach service connects you from Bristol Temple Meads to the airport every 15 minutes at peak times.

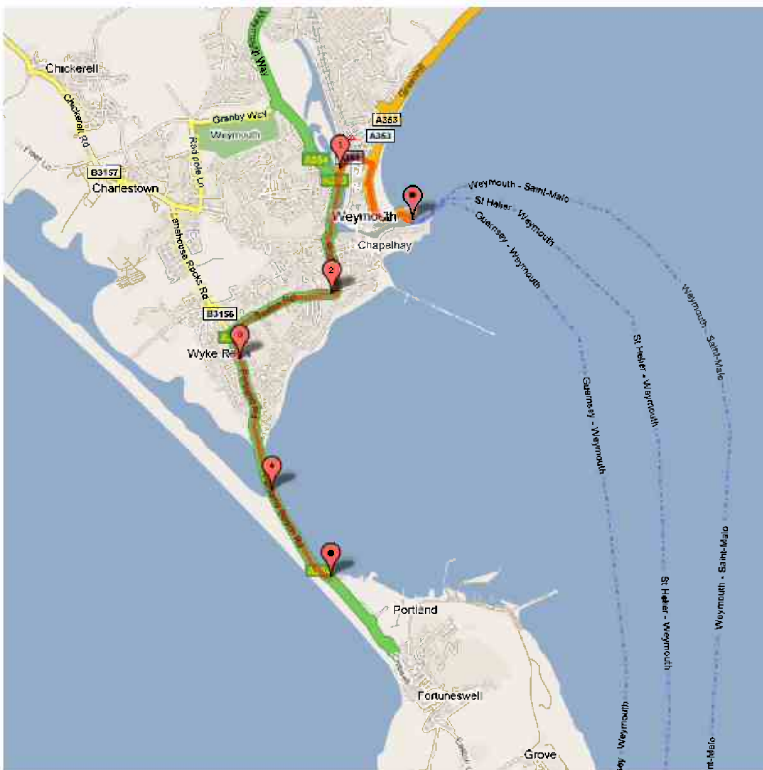

#### **To Weymouth Port**

## **To Portsmouth Port**

From Portsmouth Port, follow signs for the M27 Westbound. Keep on the M27 heading west towards Bournemouth. Then you want the A31 towards Ringwood and Bere Regis. Then take the A35 towards Dorchester. At Dorchester, at the main roundabout, take the first exit A354 towards Weymouth. Follow signs for Portland. Once on the causeway heading towards Portland, you will see the Weymouth and Portland National Sailing Academy on the left-hand side.
