



## WOMEN'S OLYMPIC MATCH RACING AT SKANDIA SAIL FOR GOLD 2009

Following the publication of the Women's Match Racing ranking on 8th July and combining this list with the results of the Yngling Class at the Olympic Games 2008 a priority list has been produced for the 20 foreign entries for the Skandia Sail for Gold regatta, this list has been agreed upon by the ISAF Women's Match Racing advisory group. The priority list is as follows,

All nations that register interest on the entry system on the website will be offered ONE entry; nations will be offered a second entry in the priority list order. So FRA first, GER second, AUS third and so on. The maximum number of foreign entries is TWENTY.

As of 10th July 2009 FOURTEEN nations have registered interest HOWEVER the closing date is 1st August 2009 so more nations may register their intentions. This means that as of 10th July only SIX nations will be offered a second entry.
