



WOMEN'S OLYMPIC MATCH RACING AT SKANDIA SAIL FOR GOLD 2009

The Organisers of the Skandia Sail for Gold Regatta 2009 confirm that it is their intention to run a Women's Olympic Match Racing event in the new Elliott 6s. We will have 8 boats and will be inviting 20 teams plus 4 teams from the host nation. We will have SIX days of racing starting on Monday 14th September through to the semi-finals and finals on Saturday 19th September. We will have practice sessions on the Saturday and Sunday before the actual event. This regatta will be the final event of the ISAF Sailing World Cup 2009 series

The entry fee will be £1,500 per team. We will run FOUR matches per flight, hopefully TEN flights a day, weather permitting, and we will be very disappointed if any team entering would compete in less than EIGHTEEN races over the regatta.

We have appointed TEN International Umpires and Jan Stage DEN will be Chief Umpire.

Entry will be on an individual basis via the Skandia Sail for Gold website, which will be up and running shortly www.skandiasailforgoldregatta.co.uk, initial applications for invitations will be accepted up to 1st August, but if we are oversubscribed then it will be one team per nation with the MNA deciding the team to be invited. All entry fees must be paid by 4th September 2009.
